Covid-19 Arrangements for all Pilgrimages and Safaris

Your health and medical safety is very important to us and that is why we have given it serious consideration. Covid -19 is undoubtedly a very serious concern for everyone in the world and as we are excited to serve you, we are also keen on keeping you and ourselves safe so that your experience is seamless. So it's important that all the precautions below are followed to the latter.

| 1 | Covid-19 Certificates and Authorization to Travel | <p>For persons that are not resident in Uganda, upon making your pilgrimage or safari reservation, you are expected to confirm whether you took your covid 19 test and the results of that test before you travel to Uganda. You must also present the certificate authorizing you to travel to Uganda from your country of origin. On arrival, you will be expected to submit a copy of your Covid – 19 negative certificate to our agent.</p> <p>For Ugandan residents, you will be expected to take a Covid-19 test at least 2 weeks before your date of pilgrimage or safari. Thereafter, you are expected to keep yourself from being exposed to the possibility of infection until your results are received. If negative, you are expected to present your Covid-19 negative certificate before you can join us for your pilgrimage or safari.</p> |  |
| 2 | Testing of Temperatures | Upon arriving to any of our pick up destinations, your temperature will be taken from arrival and every day until your departure. |  |

| 3 | Face Masks | You will be given 3 facemasks which we expect you to keep clean and re-use throughout your stay with us. |  |
| 4 | Sanitize | You will also be given your own sanitizer to use as frequently as you need to. |  |
| 5 | Wash Your Hands | Our caretakers will make provisions for you to wash your hands whenever relevant or you would like. You will however be expected to wash your hands as soon as you get to your mode of transportation and also when you are leaving at the end of each day's activities. |  |
| 6 | Social Distance | All transportation will carry only the recommended number of people per vehicle according to the recommended Covid – 19 SOPs in Uganda. |  |

| 7 | Provision of Medical Staff | Smaller groups of less than 25 people will travel with medical staff and fully equipped medical supplies to cater for any health emergencies that may arise among pilgrims or safari groups. |  |
| 8 | Emergency Medical Services | <p>In the event that you develop persistent flu-like symptoms you will be immediately isolated from the rest and sent to our travelling medical teams to test and review you before you can go back to your pilgrimage or safari.</p> <p>For this, all our long distance pilgrim groups and large safari groups of over 25 people will be escorted by medical personnel with an ambulance so that incase a medical emergency comes up, the affected persons are given quick medical care and quickly rushed to the nearest health centers. These medical staff will also ensure that everyone in the pilgrimage or safari remains medically safe throughout their stay.</p> |  |

Lastly all pilgrims and persons on safari are advised to limit their interactions with local communities and all other persons that have not been tested and protected by UGMPS from being exposed to Covid-19. You are also advised to stay within your agreed itinerary (travel plan) to ensure your health and safety. However, even with the best safety procedures, we may not protect you 100% but the measures in place, if kept, have a very high chance of keeping you safe throughout your stay with us.

Important to note is that Uganda Martyrs Pilgrimages and Safaris (UGMPS) will not be responsible for any of your medical bills in the event that you are exposed to Covid -19 or any other health/ medical issue that may arise. We shall however give you all the support we deem possible and fit to give to ensure your safe transition back to health.
